All of the once-living subject matter that I photograph makes its way to my backyard composter where it is allowed to decompose naturally. What began as a momentary pause at the window above my kitchen sink... an observation... became a meaningful photographic meditation, a practice, a necessary ritual, and a path.

The images are neither contrived nor manipulated, though they are artfully composed in my mind's eye. This food waste, that is generally seen as rotten, useless, decaying, and worthless is viewed through a more open lens, a shifted perspective.
