## Recycling Leadership Award categories include:

**Lifetime Achievement** *(An individual whose significant contributions to waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and/or composting that merit recognition over the span of a career – or that are deserving of special attention and do not fall into one of the other categories.)*

**Citizen** *(An individual whose actions or creative solutions have significantly reduced solid waste or have furthered waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and/or composting.)*

**Public Sector** *(Individual or team, whose job related actions or creative solutions have furthered waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and/or composting.)*

**Private Sector** *(An individual, team, or company, whose job related actions or creative solutions have furthered waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and/or composting.)*

**College, University, or Other Educational Institution** *(whose actions have significantly reduced solid waste or have furthered waste prevention, reuse, recycling, and/or composting.)*

**Innovation Awards** *(An innovative project or public education campaign that has resulted in significant waste reduction, reuse, recycling, and/or composting)*
